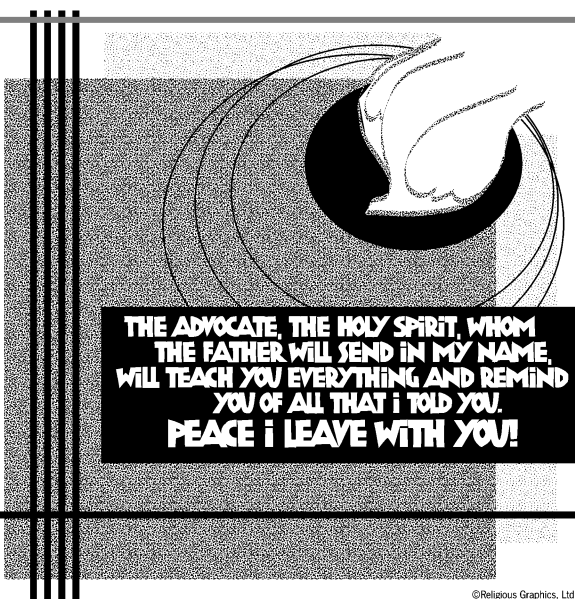

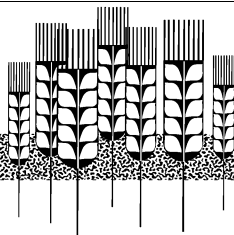

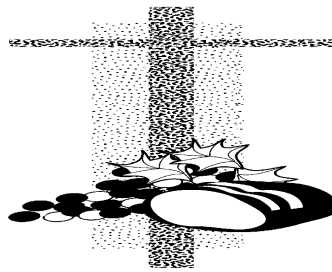
A *Worldwide Marriage Encounter Weekend* is a private weekend away from the distractions of daily life for couples in good marriages. Give your marriage this gift! The next
