





From the Pastor - Tri-Parish Leadership Meeting

On April 21, about 40 parishioners from Holy Trinity – Rollingstone, St. Joseph – Rushford, and St. Rose of Lima – Lewiston gathered in Lewiston to discuss and make plans to form our new parish cluster. It was noted that Rushford had a smaller representation than the other parishes, and that frequent turnover in pastors and not having a local office in Rushford will be a consideration for communication in the future.

Fr. Chinnappa will become pastor of St. Rose of Lima on May 19, and St. Joseph on July 1. During that time, the staff currently in place at Holy Trinity and St. Rose of Lima will remain in place. The central office for the cluster will be in Lewiston, and the residence for the pastor will also be in Lewiston, but will eventually also be in Lewiston (at the latest, when the next pastor is named). After the transition of pastors if you have any questions regarding parish life, bulletin announcements, Mass stipends, cemetery burials, or other similar needs, you may contact the Lewiston office at 523-2428.

One area of parish cluster life that will affect the most people is the Mass schedule. It was decided that the weekday Mass schedule will have to change, and that change is yet to be determined. The weekend Mass schedule, starting July 1, will be as follows: 4:30pm on Saturday at Holy Trinity, 8:00am on Sunday at St. Rose of Lima, and 10:00am at St. Joseph's. Schedules for Christmas and Holy Week will be determined at a later date with the help of the Parish Pastoral Councils. Another area that may see some changes is Faith Formation. A small group of representatives from each parish will meet in the coming weeks to decide how best to format Faith Formation for all three parishes.

When the new cluster forms, each Parish Finance Council will remain intact, as will cemetery boards. The plan for at least the next year, and as long as is necessary, one Parish Pastoral Council with equal representation from all three parishes will be formed. This will require the appointment of new Council members for St. Joseph's.

Each of the three parishes, as well as neighboring parishes that have recently merged, have different parish festivals, dinners and other celebrations that are deeply rooted. Those events were discussed at the meeting so that there is an awareness of when they take place. Each parish also has their own unique website and bulletin. These modes of communication will be streamlined so that only one of each will exist for the new cluster.

In addition to the three parishes that will compose the new cluster, there is also an oratory – Immaculate Conception in Wilson – that will remain available for occasional liturgical celebrations. There will also be a total of seven cemeteries overseen within the cluster (Holy Trinity, Oak Ridge, St. Rose of Lima, Immaculate Conception, Hart, Houston – St. Patrick's and St. Mary's).
